





Colorado Medicaid clients can access their household’s Medical Cards online anytime through their PEAK account or the [PEAKHealth app](#). Cards can be printed or viewed as long as the client is currently eligible. Medical Cards are sent to all Medicaid recipients at the time of approval and upon request. This guide provides instructions for how to print or request a Medical Card.




1. Select *Sign In* or *Manage My Account* from the PEAK home page.

Enter **Username** and **Password** from the *Sign In* screen.


Click **Sign In**.



2. Click **Request Health First Colorado Card/CHP+ Card** in the left-hand navigation bar on the *Account Overview* page.




3. Select the checkbox next to all household members who are requesting a medical card.



4a. Request to View/Print Medical Card:

Select the view or print option, then click the **View/Print Card** button. The medical cards for all household members selected will be displayed in a printable PDF document.



4b. Unable to View/Print Medical Card

Select the "I am unable to print..." option.

To access electronic medical cards using the PEAKHealth app, click on the appropriate **App Store** or **Google Play** button to download the mobile app on a mobile device.

4c. Request to Receive Medical Card in the Mail:

Select the “I am unable to print...” option.

To continue with requesting Medical Cards in the mail, click the “Request to receive card in the mail...” and the Mail Card button will display at the bottom of the page.

Note: If the request to receive a card in the mail is already being processed, a red alert message displays at the top of the page. This happens when eligibility is recently approved and/or a request to mail card was recently requested.
